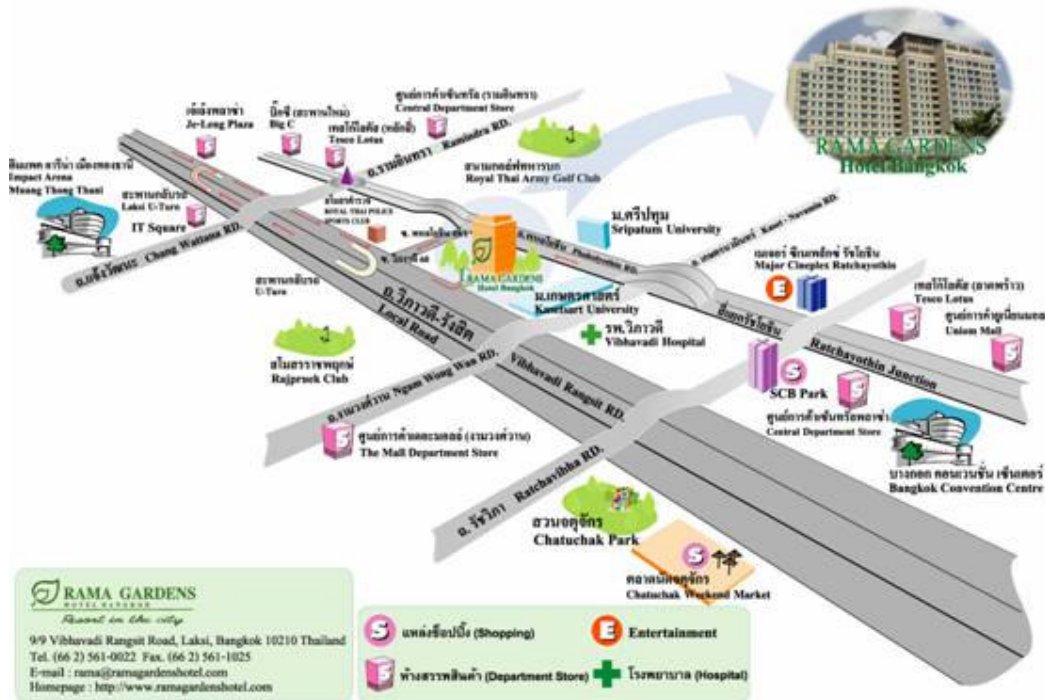

Transportation from the Suvarnabhumi Airport (BKK) to Rama Gardens Hotel

- **Taxi - Ordinary metered taxi services** are available outside the arrival hall. Contact Taxi counter, Level 2 - Arrivals, near entrances 3, 4, 7 and 8.

Approx. metered taxi fee to Rama Gardens: 400 THB plus 50 Baht airport surcharge (excluding Expressway fee)

Approx. time to Rama Gardens: 1 hr. 40 mins.

- **Limousine services** are also available but they are more expensive than taking a metered taxi.
- **Public Bus** - Public bus service is provided from the bus terminal at the Transport Center. Take a shuttle bus (Express route) to the Transport Center. Public Bus Service which bring you close to Rama Gardens Hotel:
Bus Number 555 - Suvarnabhumi Airport – Rangsit (Expressway)

Transportation to-from the Bangkok City:

If you stay other places in Bangkok, the easiest way to reach the conference venue is by **Taxi**. Taxi fare starts at 35 baht (approx. \$1) and stays there for the first

1 kilometer, and then the rate creeps up slowly at these rates:

5 baht per km for 1+ to 12 km

5.5 baht per km for 12 to 20 km

6 baht per km for 20 to 40 km

8.5 baht per kilometer for 40 to 60 km

Otherwise you may start from Mo-chit BTS skytrain station or Chatuchak subway station. Then you take bus number **29** or **510** (outbound direction) from the bus stop in front of the Chatuchak park. Please inform the bus conductor that you want to get off at Rama Gardens Hotel stop (The hotel will be located at the opposite side of the road). It is about 10-min walk to cross the road by the closest overpass. To go back to the city, the bus stop is located at the hotel gate.

Rama Gardens Hotel offers shuttle bus service for their guests to the BTS station or to the shopping area of Bangkok city. You may ask the hotel staff for the time table and further information when you arrive.
